

Starting with December 28th 2019, in case of destruction, loss, damage or delay in the international air transport as defined by art. 1 point 2 of the 1999 Convention for the unification of certain rules regarding international air transport adopted in Montreal, the liability of the transport company is limited to the value of 22 SDR/kg under the conditions of art. 22 of the Convention.

Romania has ratified the 1999 Convention for the unification of certain rules regarding international air transport adopted in Montreal by GEO no. 107/2000 on the ratification of the Convention for the unification of certain rules regarding international air transport, adopted in Montreal on May 28th 1999. Consequently, starting with December 28th 2019, TAROM Company shall compensate the people entitled in the situations mentioned above by complying with the conditions of liability and the updated limit of compensation both in the case of TAROM air transport documents (AWB) of stock which do not provide a compensation at the updated value, as well as in the case of TAROM air transport documents (AWB) which contain updated contract terms.

In other cases, where international freight air transport is based on TAROM air transport documents (AWB), either between states or in a state which has not ratified the Montreal Convention, the Company's liability shall be limited according to the applicable legal regime, this may be the one regulated by any of the conventions ratified by the states of origin and destination, respectively their internal legislation, as the case may be.
