

Notice Regarding Filing of a Request to Approve a Settlement Agreement in a Class Action Certification Request, Case No. 62910-09-24 Stern v. TAROM Romanian Air Transport

The public is hereby notified that on September 30, 2025, a request was submitted to the Tel Aviv District Court, before the Honorable Judge I. Berkowitz, for approval of a settlement agreement in a class action certification request filed by Michael Stern against TAROM Romanian Air Transport (the "**Petitioner**" and the "**Respondent**" respectively). The proceeding concerns the Petitioner's claim that the Respondent breached its disclosure and notification obligations under the **Aviation Services Law (Compensation and Assistance for Flight Cancellation or Change in Conditions), 2012 ("Aviation Services Law")** and did not provide the Petitioner, whose flight was canceled, with an alternative flight ticket and assistance services.

Main Points of the Settlement Agreement - The Respondent has committed to improve its mechanism for informing customers about their rights under the Aviation Services Law: on its website, in SMS or email notifications sent to passengers in cases of flight schedule changes, and through its ground crew staff. Additionally, the Respondent has committed to inform "Class Members" about their rights under the Aviation Services Law. Class Members are all passengers of the Respondent who were registered for flights departing from or arriving to Israel during the 4 years preceding the filing date of the certification request (the certification request was filed on September 24, 2024) and until the approval date of the settlement agreement, for whom a qualifying cause existed (a qualifying cause as defined in the Aviation Services Law). Class Members will be able to contact the Respondent and exercise their rights in accordance with the Aviation Services Law within a period of 120 days from the publication of the second notice or in accordance with the statute of limitations set by law, whichever is later. The parties recommended that the compensation to the Petitioner be set at NIS 12,500, in addition to the Respondent reimbursing the first half of the court fee, and that the Petitioner's attorneys' fees be set at a total of NIS 135,318 plus VAT.

Filing Objections and Opting Out of the Class - A class member, a public authority operating to promote a public purpose related to the matter addressed in the certification request or claim, an organization operating to promote such a public purpose, as well as the Attorney General, may submit to the Court, in writing, within 45 days from the publication of this notice, a reasoned objection to the settlement agreement and to the agreed recommendation regarding compensation and attorneys' fees. A class member who does not wish to be bound by the settlement agreement may notify the Court, within the period set for filing objections as stated in Section 18(f) of the Law, that they do not wish the settlement agreement to apply to them.

Res Judicata - Approval of the settlement agreement according to its terms constitutes a final and complete settlement of the rights of the Petitioner and the class members regarding the cause of action mentioned in the certification request. Therefore, approval of the settlement agreement by the Honorable Court constitutes a final and absolute res judicata for the class members.

Reviewing the Settlement Agreement - The settlement agreement is available for review by the class in the Class Actions Registry, at the Court Secretariat, and on Attorney Ron Solan's website at www.solron.co.il.

Miscellaneous - The full text of the settlement agreement is binding, and in any contradiction between its provisions and what is stated in this notice, the provisions of the request to approve the settlement agreement shall prevail. The content of this notice has been approved by the Court and is published in accordance with its decision.
